Projects Update

Another busy season of projects on the premises are wrapping up. Most notably the **Paver project** has been completed with old pavers replaced and reset with new pavers in the main courtyard along with a number of individual landings. The project was completed on time and on budget.

The **Snow Melt System** has been upgraded with balcony shut off valves added to each unit's upper balcony. This is the preferred method to isolate glycol leaks in the system which, at this time, remain an issue that we're troubleshooting. Having the snow melt system functioning properly is a top priority as early weather predictions are calling for a big snow year. Fingers crossed.

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Check your Carbon Monoxide/Fire Detectors

With winter upon us we are urging all owners to have interior fire detectors tested. The average unit lasts 7-10 years. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to see that all devices are functioning properly. Let's have a safe winter!

Updated CC&R's

The HOA's CC&R's have been updated and will be available to review on the new website. It addresses the new Idaho codes relating to HOA's passed by the 2025 Idaho state legislature.

Windows Update

Viewpoint Windows have been on site to inspect a number of Sierra Pacific windows that have failed throughout the development. The good news is that the degraded seals in the windows are still covered by the warranty. Unfortunately, the re-installation costs are the responsibility of the homeowner.

Projects (continued)

Roof repairs to address ice buildup in trouble spots on 3 buildings are done. This involved replacing broken down underlayment and shingles where moisture had infiltrated above units 5, 8, and 10. The repair cost comes from the Capex fund. We ask all homeowners to regularly check exterior walls and ceilings as the snow piles up so that we can stay ahead of any potential leaks.

Tree trimming this year addressed a number of problem areas where trees were overcrowded or growing too closely to the buildings. This pruning and removal maintenance becomes more critical as our foliage ages.

Fall Cleanup is near complete and we expect one more leaf pickup from our grounds crew at Clearwater Landscaping before the snow flies.
